Jim also works very hard off the water as a product consultant, tackle designer, seminar speaker, and tournament emcee at events like the North Dakota Governor's Walleye Cup. He is deeply committed to the future of the sportfishing industry. Jim is currently an AIM Board Member, and a lifetime member of Lure 'em for Life which is an organization of North Dakota volunteers who teach fishing and aquatic education to children.

Jim will be presenting on the topic "Using Electronics to Find and Catch More Fish!"

DAVE CSANDA: Dave has enjoyed nearly 40 years in the fishing industry, beginning as an editor of In-Fisherman publications and co-host of In-Fisherman Television. At Lindner Media Productions, he helped create Angling Edge and Fishing Edge TV, educational DVDs, and bring AnglingBuzz to the web. He is an inductee of both the Minnesota and National Fresh Water Fishing Halls of Fame.

Currently, Dave serves as Associate Editor of Midwest Outdoors, which covers the outdoors on a monthly basis via print, TV and the web. He also contributes educational articles to a variety of fishing and outdoor publications, performs frequent radio interviews, and maintains an active seminar schedule at sport shows, fishing clubs and in-store promotions.

Dave's seminar topics include "River Walleyes-Go with the Flow" and "Bass in Rivers and Reservoirs."
