MEET THE PROS APPEARING AT THE SIOUX EMPIRE SPORTSMEN'S SHOW

JASON MITCHELL: Jason Mitchell is host and producer of television's "Jason Mitchell Outdoors," one of the most highly viewed outdoor programs in the Midwest. Before starting his broadcast career, he was well-known as one of the best guides on Devil's Lake in North Dakota. He has earned a reputation as a willing and able teacher whose time on the water is hard to duplicate. In 2016, he was inducted into the North Dakota Fishing Hall of Fame.

Jason's seminar topic is "Advanced Trolling Tactics for Walleye." He'll be at the show on Thursday and Friday.

TED TAKASAKI: A Hall of Fame Legendary angler, Ted is one of the top competitors on the FLW Walleye Tour and the Professional Walleye Trail. He won the prestigious PWT Classic Championship in 1998 and the 1995 PWT Top Gun Angler Award. He still holds the all-time tournament record for a one day limit of five walleyes, which weighed an amazing 53.2 pounds.

From 1999 to 2008, Ted was president of Lindy Fishing Tackle, one of the nation's largest freshwater fishing tackle manufacturers. He has been featured in many national outdoor magazines, has conducted hundreds of walleye seminars across the Midwest, and has appeared on numerous fishing television shows. Ted is considered one of America's top walleye and multi-species anglers.

Ted's weekend seminar topics are "Troll in 4 Wheel Drive" and "Jig Like a Pro."

TODD AMENRUD: Todd is a full time sportsman whose job keeps him in the outdoors much of the year. He is addicted to bow hunting for whitetail, and spends a considerable amount of time researching, studying and learning about them. He also hunts other big game, turkey and waterfowl throughout the country and Canada.

Todd is the author of three books on whitetail, including *Details for Whitetail*. He has trained extensively on whitetail management, habitat improvement and planting food plots. In addition, he is certified through the state of Minnesota as an instructor for bow hunter education, firearms safety and advanced hunter education. He currently writes columns in over 60 outdoor and general circulation publications.

Todd will be appearing at the Sportsmen's Show every day. His topics are "Tactics for Conquering a Whitetail's Sense of Smell" and "How to Grow the Most Attractive Food Plots for Whitetail."
